TEACHER SUMMATIVE ASSESSMENT RUBRIC: AFL UMPIRING

Upon completion of the School Umpiring Course, students can:

- Demonstrate a thorough understanding of the rules of AFL and their application during a match.
- Accurately explain and interpret the rules when questioned.
- Apply the rules consistently and fairly throughout the game.
- Understand the importance of maintaining appropriate positioning on the field to have a clear view of the play.
- Demonstrate an understanding of the optimal angles and distances for making accurate decisions.
- Show awareness of player positions and potential infringements in various areas of the field.
- Make prompt and accurate decisions based on the rules and the actions observed.
- Demonstrate fair and unbiased decision making.
- Communicate decisions clearly and effectively to players, coaches, and spectators.
- Uses appropriate verbal and non-verbal signals to indicate decisions and actions taken.
- Exhibits leadership qualities by maintaining control and authority throughout the match.
- Demonstrate professionalism and acts in accordance with the spirit of the game (fairness and respect).

After completing the Umpire Course, this assessment task can be used to demonstrate student learning and indicate how students have applied their knowledge and skills throughout the unit.

Implementation suggestions:

• Show students the rubric below and discuss what success would look like. This would be most useful before beginning the course to articulate what the intended learning outcomes are for the unit. It may also provide an understanding of students' prior learning and can therefore be applied as a formative assessment rubric.

• A feedback session is suggested for students to understand their performance overall, to discuss the results and allow time to reflect on how they might be able to further improve performance.
