## **OVERVIEW**

The Australian Football Facilities Fund (AFFF) is committed to supporting the provision of well positioned, welcoming, accessible, fit for purpose football facilities that support our growing game's strategic priorities. This is done through creating access to new playing fields and upgrading amenities at new and existing venues.

The upgrade of Margaret Donoghoe Sportsground (Aulich Park) involved improving the existing spectator space to increase capacity with undercover seating and additional standing areas, along with upgraded technology to provide better education and training experiences for volunteers, players and visiting organisations.

This project has been beneficial to the whole community, not just the club, by not only addressing the wear and tear of the existing pavilion (which was identified as a potential safety hazard), but also installing security fencing to prevent future break ins and vandalism. The completed project ensures the safety of all participants and volunteers, fostering a secure and welcoming environment at the venue.

The technology improvements and added spectator capacity now enables an additional 10 hours per week of venue access for community and pathway football, in this case to the GWS Giants academy. This project highlights how beneficial outcomes are achieved through partnerships between local football clubs and the AFL. It serves as an example of addressing areas in need of improvement, benefitting the local club and community, while also supporting talent pathways into our elite game.

## **Project Outcomes**

- Extra undercover areas for spectators, officials and players
- 10 new hours per week of football utilisation to the venue
- Audio visual improvements enhanced education and training experiences for volunteers, players and visiting organisations
