THIS GUIDANCE HAS BEEN CREATED AFTER DISCUSSIONS WITH WOMEN AND GIRLS LIASONS ABOUT HOW TO SUPPORT NEW UMPIRES WHEN WHEN JOINING AN UMPIRING GROUP.

WHAT

Welcome packs are physical or digital packs of information and resources given to new and returning umpires at the begining of the season.

WHY

The packs will help umpires begin their journey into umpiring by providing them with the information and resources needed to feel comfortable in a new environment. Packs can also be created for returning umpires which includes incentives to encourage them to return.

THE BENEFITS

- Supports new umpires to feel included in the group
- Ensures new umpires feel informed about the next steps for registration.
- Cleary communicates the values of the umpire group through the existing policies and codes of conducts.
- Promotes social events avaliable to the umpires.
- Helps new umpires to feel well-prepared before their first game!
