WHO IS DELIVERING THIS YEAR'S PROGRAM?

This program has been developed and will be delivered by AFL Victoria. Workhops and educations will be presented by facilitators from AFL Victoria, the AFL, and external organisations with experience and expertise in the industry or relevant areas. More detail around individual presentations and speakers/organisations will be shared closer to the program dates.

WHAT IF I AM NOT SUCCESSFUL IN MY APPLICATION?

Unfortunately, places in the Lead Your Way program are strictly limited, and we will not be able to accommodate all who apply. All applicants - both successful and unsuccessful - will be informed of the outcome of their application via the date detailed in the program guide. Unfortunately, due to the number of applications submitted, we are not able to provide feedback to all applicants when offers are communicated. If you are seeking feedback, please reach out.

Some applicants may be waitlisted. Should places become available after program offers have been made, those applicants will be contacted directly. Applicants who are not accepted into the program in 2024 and welcome and encouraged to reapply for future programs and opportunities.

WHAT IF MY CLUB ONLY HAS MEN'S TEAMS - CAN I STILL APPLY?

Acceptance into this program is on the merits of your application. not the teams at your club. Women and gender diverse leaders from any Victorian football club are welcome to apply, regardless of the teams or structure of their club.

WHEN WILL THE WORKSHOPS TAKE PLACE?

We know that most volunteers contribute to their clubs in addition to full-time work. As such, all of our workshops and events are delivered outside of a standard working week. Webinars will all be scheduled in the evening on weeknights, while the two face-to-face sessions will take place on a Saturday or Sunday during the day.



WHY CAN ONLY CERTAIN PEOPLE APPLY FOR THIS PROGRAM?

This program has strict eligibility criteria. It has been developed to align with goals of the AFL Women and Girls Action Plan and the AFL Women's Vision. The Women's Football Vision objective for participation is striving for equal participation and representation by 2030. This translates into:

- Equal opportunity for women and girls to play, coach, umpire, officiate and govern.
- A participation pathway that best supports the continued development of participants and enables lifelong participation in the game.

HOW MUCH DOES THE PROGRAM COST?

This program is funded by AFL Victoria through the Women and Girls Action Plan. There are no fees for participants to attend the education and networking sessions.

WHAT IF I NEED TO TRAVEL?

Unfortunately, we are not able to fund costs that fall outside of program delivery, such as meals (unless otherwise communicated), travel, parking, or accommodation.

If financial barriers relating to the above may impact your ability to attend, please apply and outline this information in in the final section of your application, as we are committed to facilitating reasonable adjustments to remove barriers to participation where possible. I LIVE OUTSIDE OF VICTORIA; CAN I APPLY FOR THIS PROGRAM?

If you live in a border town and are aligned with a club that is based inside the Victorian border, or aligned with an AFL Victoria Country region, you are eligible to apply for this program.

CAN I APPLY IF I AM NOT CURRENTLY IN A POSITION AT A COMMUNITY FOOTBALL CLUB?

Though we value and appreciate the contributions of past leaders, they are not eligible for this program. This program is designed for people who are in current leadership positions at community football clubs, who can apply this learning in their current role this football season.

If you are yet to step into a leadership role at your club, we encourage you to do so and consider applying in future years.

I AM A SOLE PARENT, IS THERE SUPPORT FOR ME TO ATTEND?

If parental responsibilities present a barrier for you to attend, please apply and outline this information in the final section of your application, as we are committed to facilitating reasonable adjustments to remove barriers to participation where possible. This information will not impact decisions regarding your application, and we may be in contact to discuss your needs further.

I AM A COACH/UMPIRE/PLAYER LEADER. CAN I APPLY FOR THIS PROGRAM?

This program is not designed for leadership outside of those in committee and governance positions. Coaches, Umpires, and clubs can seek development and education relevant to their roles through other programs offered through AFL Victoria and the AFL.

Coaches, umpires, and players who hold dual positions as a senior committee leader are eligible to apply for this program in 2024. Example: Club Secretary who is also a team vice-captain.

I AM A LEADER IN A LEAGUE/REGION CAPACITY. CAN I APPLY FOR THIS PROGRAM?

This program is strictly for those in leadership in community football clubs. Therefore, leaders from leagues or region boards are not eligible unless they hold a duel role as a club volunteer.
