ABOUT THE 2025 PROGRAM

Lead Your Way aims to progress the skills and network of women and gender diverse leaders across a series of development and networking events. The program launched for the first time in 2024 in connection with the AFL's BHP Women's Leadership Series.

The BHP Women's Leadership Series has been developed in line with the AFL's Women and Girls Action Plan and is intended to support women to thrive in leadership and committee position in Community Football Clubs across the country.

AFL Victoria will be delivering Lead Your Way again in 2025 to support people holding current leadership positions as a volunteer in Community Football Clubs. The program is tailored to support senior leaders at club committee, board or executive levels.

The program will run from March to October with our program launch event scheduled for the 8th of March. Ongoing dates and details will be communicated to successful applicants as they become available.

The Victorian program will be supported by two national online events, a leadership development webinar, and an invitation to the BHP Think Big Leadership Forum.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA – WHO CAN APPLY

To participate in the program, you must:

- identify as a women or gender diverse.
- be over the age of 18.
- hold a current leadership position as a committee volunteer within a Community Football Club
- reside within the state of Victoria/be associated with an AFL Victoria club

DIVERSITY

The program seeks a diverse cohort to ensure an intersectional approach to leadership within club communities, and to support the goals of inclusive and diverse environments as included in the AFL Women and Girls Action plan. This includes but is not limited to people identifying as:

- Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander
- culturally and/or religiously diverse people
- LGBTIOA+
- · people from rural and regional communities, and
- · people with disabilities.

SELECTION CRITERIA

In your application, you will be asked to provide information on the following subjects:

- Tell us about yourself general information about who you are and how to contact you.
- Your community football club.
- Your leadership experience, including current leadership role/s.
- How you think that this program will support your development and have a positive impact on your club and leadership.
- Your views on challenges, barriers, and issues for women and gender diverse people in Community Football, and what you would like to gain from this program.

Your application responses should show:

- Your leadership experience in community sport
- Why you want to be a part of this program
- Your personal leadership goals/what you want to achieve through Lead Your Way
- consideration for how this program can lead to positive impact and change for women in leadership and in community football clubs more broadly.

All applicants will be notified of the outcome of their application via email no later that Tuesday 18 February 2025.
