The AFL Victoria Community Football Facility Award annually recognises best practise in community football facility development across the State, along with the people, clubs, local governments and other stakeholders driving our best projects These awards aim to showcase the best projects that support the provision of well positioned, welcoming, fit for purpose football facilities that support our growing game's strategic priorities. AFL Victoria's winning project will be nominated for the National AFL Ken Gannon Community Football Facilities Award.

PROJECT CRITERIA

Projects should deliver on one or more of the following strategic priorities:

- 1. Maximise the carrying capacity of existing venues
- 2. Develop new and increased capacity through construction of new ovals
- 3. Provide inclusive and accessible facilities. that cater for the diversity of participants, particularly female participants
- 4. Develop venues to support the game's talent pathway and umpires

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible, your project must be related to community level football. The project must have been completed and venue used for Australian Rules Football in the 2025 year.

Eligible nominating organisations are:

- · Local Government Authorities
- · AFL Vic Regions
- · Metropolitan Football Leagues
- · Educational Institutions
