# **2026 UMPIRE EDUCATION COURSES**BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The AFL is committed to providing community Umpires and Umpire Coaches with access to education that promotes the development of those involved in community umpiring and supporting those wishing to pursue the umpire talent pathway.

For the 2026 season, the AFL is pleased to introduce two mandatory courses for new Umpires and all community Umpire Coaches, which replace the mandatory Umpire Education Modules used in previous seasons.

New Umpires will be required to complete the Foundation Umpire Course and all community Umpire Coaches will be required to complete the Foundation Umpire Coach Course, with each course taking approximately 30 – 40 minutes.

Returning Umpires from the 2025 season do not have any mandatory Umpire Education Course to complete for season 2026. However, they do have the option to complete the Foundation Umpire Course if they choose to do so.

The Foundation courses are compulsory for new umpires and all umpire coaches, who will initially be marked as 'unavailable' for appointments within OfficialsHQ. Once the education course has been completed, they will become eligible for match appointments and able to be selected in the OfficialsHQ platform. Returning Umpires from the 2025 season will be available for appointments following the completion of registration. Please note that this may take up to 24 hours to be visible in OfficialsHQ.

You will be able to access the Umpire Education Course through your OfficialsHQ profile. You will also be required to link your AFLiD, or create one, to your OfficialsHQ & LMS accounts. This feature will provide all umpires and umpire coaches with an improved user experience across all AFL platforms.

This communication will be sent by the S&T Umpiring Dept to all umpires/coaches within their State/Territory on 10/11/2025. A link to the user guide is included in the below email.

Dear Umpires and Umpire Coaches,

Last week the AFL sent an email to all umpires and umpire coaches announcing the opening of 2026 umpire registrations and the introduction of the new Foundation Umpire and Foundation Umpire Coach Courses.

In recent months, the **[add S&T name]** Umpiring Department has been working collectively with the AFL to further enhance our umpire operations and services provided to you. As a result, the mandatory Umpire Education Modules used in previous years have been replaced with the Foundation Umpire Course & Foundation Umpire Coach Course.

In 2026, new Umpires will be required to complete the Foundation Umpire Course and all community Umpire Coaches will be required to complete the Foundation Umpire Coach Course. Each course should take approximately 30 - 40 minutes to complete.

Returning Umpires from the 2025 season do not have any mandatory Umpire Education Course to complete for season 2026. However, they do have the option to complete the Foundation Umpire Course if they choose to do so.

The Foundation courses are compulsory for new umpires and all umpire coaches, who will initially be marked as 'unavailable' for appointments within OfficialsHQ. Once the education course has been completed, they will become eligible for match appointments and able to be selected in the OfficialsHQ platform. Returning Umpires from the 2025 season will be available for appointments following the completion of registration. Please note that this may take up to 24 hours to be visible in OfficialsHQ.

## eDM 3 - Local Umpiring Group Communication to local umpires & umpire coaches on 17/11/25

In recent weeks, the AFL communicated to all umpires and umpire coaches nationally the 2026 Umpire Education Course requirements with the introduction of the two courses for new Umpires and all Umpire Coaches.

- New Umpires Foundation Umpire Course
- All Umpire Coaches Foundation Umpire Coach Course

The Umpire Education Courses serve as an important aspect delivered by the AFL to provide continuous improvement and professional development to all Umpire and Umpire Coaches across Australia and replace the mandatory Umpire Education Modules used in previous years.

Most notably, new Umpires and all Umpire Coaches will initially be marked as 'unavailable' for appointments within OfficialsHQ. Completion of the Education Course via the AFL Learning Management System (LMS) will automatically update your availability status in OfficialsHQ to 'available', allowing you to be considered for match appointments. Please note that this may take up to 24 hours to become visible.

Returning Umpires from the 2025 season do not have any mandatory Umpire Education Course to complete for season 2026. However, they do have the option to complete the Foundation Umpire Course if they choose to do so. Umpires returning from 2025 will be available for appointments following the completion of their registration.

We kindly request that those required complete the Foundation Umpire Education Course do so as soon as possible to allow us to appoint you to matches once the season commences.
