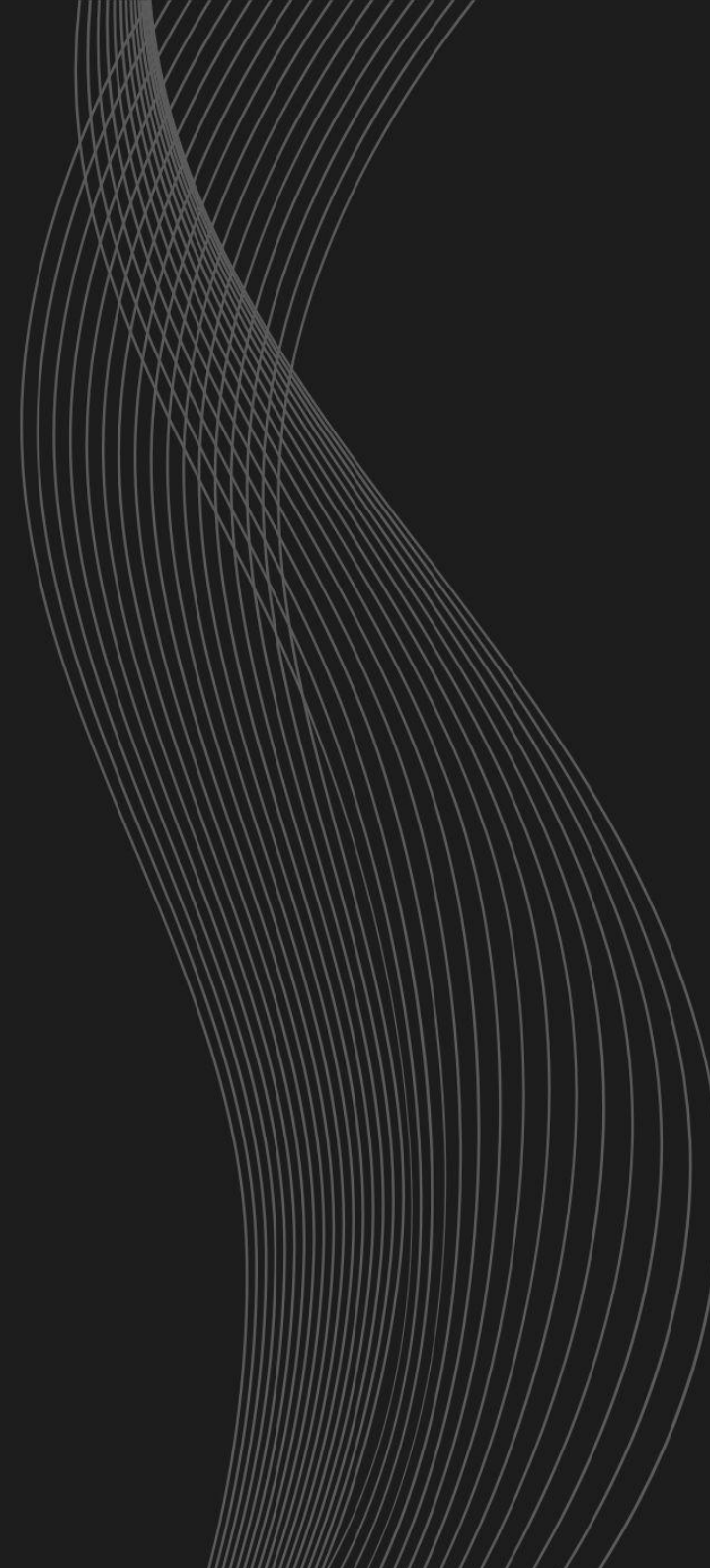




GOAL UMPIRE PERFORMANCE PRINCIPLES

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PERFORMANCE PRINCIPLES

Fundamentals Intensity and Urgency

Performance Indicators

- Work rate to make Position.
- Aggressive / Decisive Movements
- Strong Body Language and Indications

Positioning

Post Positioning

Performance Indicator - (Makes every effort to be Settled prior to the ball crossing the line / Appropriate Distance Back from the Post / Protects Goal Side)

Online Positioning

Performance Indicator - (Makes every effort to be Settled prior to the ball crossing the line / Appropriate Distance Back from the Post / Protects Goal Side)

Behind the Flight / Line of the Ball Positioning

Performance Indicator - (Correctly chooses to take up an online position for touchable balls close to and beyond the scoring line. The Umpire is in a settled position prior to the contest / ball crossing the line)

Behind the Flight / Line of the Ball Positioning

Performance Indicator - (Correctly remains behind the line/flight of the ball in non-contestable situations. Makes every effort to work post side of the ball for balls tracking towards a goal post)

Positioning Distance from Post / Contest

Performance Indicator - (Allows appropriate distance from the goal post.
Positions close enough to the play whilst maintaining a safe working distance)

Use of Angle and Depth

Performance Indicators - (Running pattern is not narrow, uses all available space when moving out wide)

Set Shot Set Up

Performance Indicator - (Correctly sets up, giving consideration to the angle of the kick, distance from goal and player traffic)

General Play Set Up

Performance Indicator - (Adapts to changing circumstances. Works back from or closer to the scoring line as required)

Low Risk V High Risk

Performance Indicator (Maintains Safe Positioning/Does not overcommit, compromise the goal area or position dangerously)

Communication

Communication with Boundary Umpires

Performance indicators Boundary Assists

- Provides "Necessary" Support
- Appropriate use of Physical and Verbal Communication

Scoring Scenarios

- Clear understanding and communication with close to the behind line / behind post scoring situations

Communication with Field Umpires

Performance Indicators

- All Clears - Active in Chasing

- Strong Body Language indicating Marks close to the scoring line/balls just clearing the scoring line.
- Assisting as required with Mark "in/outside" the goal square.

Consultation Processes

Performance indicators

- Taking Ownership of the Consultation Process
- Ensuring all available resources are used within the Consultation Process
- Composure

Concentration and Awareness

Performance Indicators

Continually surveys "impacts" at stoppages and adjusting as play evolves

Fully aware of the position of other Umpires

Appropriately adjusts to match circumstances/weather conditions.

Application of Rules

- Behind the Scoring Line Scenarios
- Kick after the Siren Scenarios

- Mark in the Goal Square Scenarios
- Scoring Interpretations (e.g. kick above/below the knee)



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
